F-3 Student Perception Survey

Suitable for:

- Students in year levels from Foundation to Year 3
- Primary students with EAL requirements
- Primary and Secondary students with intellectual challenges

Format:

- 10 Questions (AITSL Aligned)
- Developmentally appropriate 3 Point response scale (Always, Sometimes, Never) only one question per screen



Standard Student Perception Survey (Simplified language)

Suitable for:

- Year 3 students
- Upper primary students from Years 4-6
- Secondary students with literacy needs

Format:

- 25 Questions (AITSL Aligned) with extra question customisation options
- 5 Point response scale (Strongly agree - Strongly disagree)
- This format has emoticons and simplified language



Standard Student Perception Survey

Suitable for:

- Secondary students from Years 7 to high school completion
- Upper Primary students
- Senior Secondary programs E.g. VCAL

Format:

- 25 Questions (AITSL Aligned) with extra question customisation options
- 5 Point response scale (Strongly agree - Strongly disagree)



Distance Learning Survey

Suitable for:

- Students from Years 4-12+ in a remote and flexible learning format
- Students returning from a period of at home learning

Format:

- 25 Questions focused on online learning (AITSL Aligned) plus an additional 5 questions on student wellbeing and connectedness
- 5 Point response scale (strongly agree - strongly disagree)
